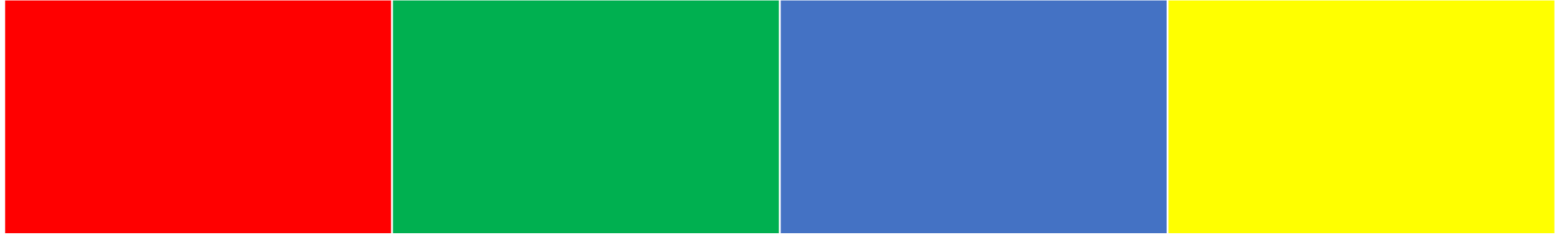

# Reading

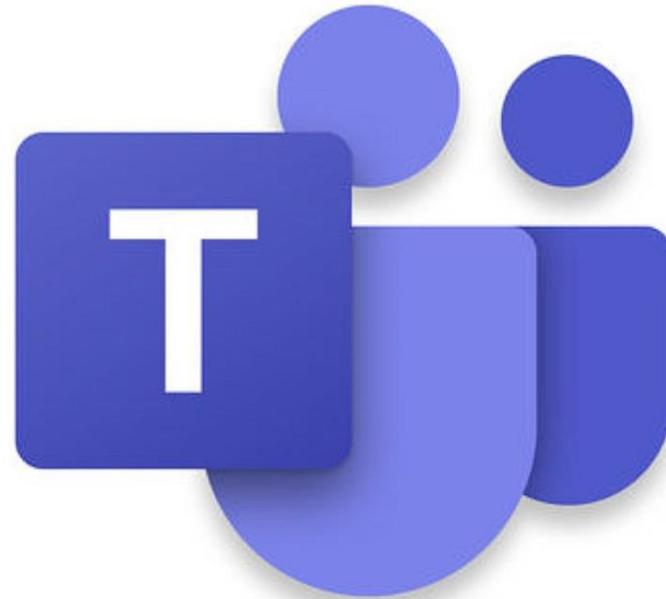
Reading changes a lot in Year 3.
